8691 WEB SITE

8692 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

8693 PLANNING

(It was noted that Councillor Hitchins took no part in the voting on planning as he will be considering the applications as a Member of the District Council's Planning Committee)

The following planning applications were considered:-

- 04/1692/15/LB Listed Building consent for repairs to barn and separate lean-to including new roof, floor and stonework, **Ashleigh Farm, Peter Hopper's Hill, Tamerton Foliot, Plymouth. It was AGREED to RECOMMEND APPROVAL**
- 04/1727/15/F Proposed conversion of existing garage into bedroom, single storey side extension forming utility room and extension to dining area, **17 Rowan Way, Woolwell, PL6 7SU. It was AGREED to RECOMMEND APPROVAL subject to no neighbour objection.**
- 04/1620/15/F Two-storey side extension, **3 Riverford Close, Woolwell, PL6 7QG. It was AGREED to RECOMMEND APPROVAL having noted present parking problems,**

8694 CHAIRMAN'S TIME

- (a) Problems with grass cutting were raised. Councillor Hitchins stated that he was having a meeting with the contractor.

- (b) Problems with the deer on Woolwell was raised as 26 deer had been seen on the roundabout by Tesco. Enquiries were on-going.
- (c) Councillors stated that fly-tipping has risen in the Parish since parishioners were no longer able to take rubbish to Chelson Meadow.
- (d) Concern has been expressed that a business is being run from a property at The Heathers which is causing problems with parking. This has been reported to the Police but no action can be taken unless a formal complaint is made.
- (e) Councillor Hitchins reported that City Bus will run the No. 42 bus and the frequency will be as now, although there will be 10 days during the transfer when there will be no buses.
- (f) It was noted that Plymouth is removing the bottle banks from Tesco.
