- (c) There is concern regarding safety from balls being hit by cricketers. This could be resolved by the erection of netting to prevent balls from entering the site and thus avoiding possible future conflict
- (d) For correctness, the Parish Council would like to point out that they are not owners of the playing field but Custodian Trustees. The Roborough Recreation Hall and Playing Fields Trustees are responsible for the running of the playing field.
