Joint Local Plan – Update

On 31 July 2017 Plymouth City Council, South Hams District Council and West Devon Borough Council submitted the Plymouth and South West Devon Joint Local Plan to the Secretary of State. Wendy Burden BA DipTP MRTPI and Yvonne Wright BSc (Hons) DIPT&CP MSc MRTPI were appointed as the Inspectors to the Plan.

The examination will commence on Tuesday 30 January 2018 and run for several weeks; most sessions will be held at the Ballroom, New Continental Hotel, Millbay Road, Plymouth, PL1 3LD. Details of venues for the sessions in South Hams and West Devon will be released in future updates.
