Minutes of a meeting of Bickleigh Parish Council held on Thursday 23rd March 2023 at 7.30pm in the Roborough Village Hall

Present: Councillors Carole Spencer (Chair), Brian Hill, Lindy Scott.

In Attendance: District Councillor Barrie Spencer, Mrs H Broughton (Clerk) and 2 members of the public.

Open Forum

A grant application had recently been submitted to the parish council from Bickleigh Village for a defibrillator to be fitted to the external church wall. Cllr Spencer had agreed to give £300 from his locality fund. £1,500 was being requested, with this being refunded should any other bids be successful. The Chair advised that unfortunately the grant application had been received too late to be included on the agenda for this meeting and, due to the preelection period, this will now have to wait until May.

A Coronation Lunch was being held on May 7th.

- 2023 40 Apologies for absence were received from Cllr N Hopwood (previous engagement), Cllr P Blight (work), Cllr L Tamsett-White (work), Cllr J Taylor (holiday) and Cllr L Taylor (holiday). These were accepted by the Council.

- 2023 42 **Dispensations:** There were none.
- 2023 43 It was agreed that the **minutes** of the Parish Council Meeting held on 23rd February 2023 be signed by the Chair as a true record.
- The Woolwell Centre Working Group minutes of a meeting held on 1st March 2023 were noted.
